The completed plans will include some of the following:


- An overview of your objectives and conditions
- Technical plan maps for existing and planned practices
- Design and implementation details including selected practices and locations
- A timeline for planting
- Plant lists
- Site preparation, maintenance and monitoring guidance

The plans will meet all requirements of USDA-NRCS's technical documentation, preparing you to apply for implementation programs, including those funded by NRCS, CA Dept of Food & Ag, and CA Dept of Fish & Wildlife.

Some of the many practices that could be outlined in the plans include hedgerows, windbreaks, riparian buffers, grassed waterways, filter strips and field borders.
